One of the great joys of working in our schools is visiting the Early Years classes and sharing stories with them. At this time of year, I bring the Nativity figures, and tell the story to the children in Nursery, Reception and Year I. They always have such great questions, and this year, the question that came up twice really struck me: 'How do you know all about Jesus?'

I replied, 'When I was little, my parents had a Nativity set and I learned the story, and when I was at school we did Nativity plays, and in the Bible you can read all the stories about Jesus, including the story of his birth at the very first Christmas.'

But the question left me wondering how many people still don't really know the story of Jesus. In Year I, we talked about the gifts that the Three Kings brought,



gold, frankincense and myrrh. Gold for a King, frankincense for a priest, and myrrh for someone who would die. In our telling of the Nativity story, we remember that the baby Jesus grew up into a man, and that 'he died and rose again, which is very sad and very wonderful, in an Easter kind of way'.

How many people don't know the story, or only know the Nativity part of the story? When I answered the question, another followed: 'How did your parents know?'

Well, of course, their parents told them as parents, and family, and Church family have been doing so for 2000 years. We keep telling the story afresh every year; finding the joy and hope and love of God in the retelling.

I've had the joy of some sneaky previews of the Nativity plays that will be performed in the coming weeks, and I know that these children are getting excited about their part in retelling the story once again. May we have fresh ears to hear it and generous hearts to share it!
