This year, Easter falls late and so in thinking about what to tackle in our Life Groups, it seemed a good opportunity to explore the Gospel of John, and to discover what the 'disciple-whom-Jesus-loved' has to say

SCAN ME

regarding the life of Jesus. John's Gospel is 21 chapters of not just eye-witness testimony, but of reflection and theology. So we have started the journey!

The Tuesday evening Zoom Life Group and the Wednesday daytime Life Group are both exploring John in bite-sized pieces, which will see our weekly groups travelling to Easter and beyond to explore the whole Gospel. The timing of the sessions will mean that we can explore the chapters where Jesus approaches his death and passion as we too approach Passiontide and Easter. The Thursday fortnightly Life Group are approaching the Gospel through the 'seven miraculous signs' of Jesus, which John chose to fulfil his purpose in writing his Gospel: 'these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.' (John 20:31)

John's Gospel is fascinating, as it tells you clearly what it is for, but hidden alongside that simple explanation is a complex structure and in depth planning. Why not take a look at the Bible Project's explanation of the structure of John's Gospel as a starting point? (See: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=G-2e9mMf7E8).

Maybe coming to a Life Group isn't something that you have done before? You are welcome to join us and try it out! Maybe you can't fit it in your schedule, so what about doing it in your own time? There's a new app called 'The Word one to one' that takes you through the whole of John in bite-sized pieces. Maybe you could find a friend to share it with?

It would be wonderful to have everyone in our congregations exploring the Gospel of John, and going deeper into their understanding of Jesus of Nazareth, Rabbi, Teacher, Lamb of God, Messiah, Son of Man, King of Israel, Son of God!
