Hooray! Christmas is here!

A Facebook discussion about what prayers you use for carol services reminded me that the traditions of the church keeps shifting and changing all the time, and sometimes not necessarily for the better. Christmas is here, but in a world that pushes Advent out and starts decorating Christmas trees at the end of November, most people are putting away the Christmas celebrations, even before the New Year has rolled in.

Traditionally, The Festival of Christmas lasts for 40 days from late on Christmas Eve until the 2nd of February, so for us Christians Christmas is just beginning! The trouble is that Advent ended so easily somewhere in the third week of December, that the celebrating can run out of steam. Traditionally, Christmas carol services happened after Christmas Day, but we've been listening to Christmas music since November on the radio and in the shops. So what are we going to do in this Christmas Festival? How can we serve God and celebrate his love when we're all tinselled out?

Perhaps the best thing to do is to focus on the message of the angels: 'Do not be afraid, for I bring you good news!'

I have been thinking about the lovely, 'calm and bright' sanitised story of the Nativity this year, and realising that it wasn't! It wasn't clean or tidy or filled with sunshine and Christmas roses.... It was dirty and messy and terrifying, with fear and uncertainty all around! But the angels brought the two fold message: 'Do not be afraid' and 'A Saviour has been born!'

During our School Carol Services the children hit the nail on the head about fear. Why don't we need to be afraid? Because God is with us always! This is the Good News! Quick, share it! In the messiness of real lives, in sorrow and pain, poverty and suffering, conflict and complex situations, people need to hear that we do not need to be afraid, because God is with us!
