The summer is here and it's Baptism Season! I have had several people comment that it is lovely to have the opportunity to welcome more families into church for Baptism, especially after the restrictions of the last few years.

But there is also another reason why we are able to welcome more people, which is a changing theological understanding of what Baptism for children might mean. Within the liturgy, week on week, we remind ourselves that 'God so loved the world that he gave his only son Jesus Christ to save us from our sins, to be our advocate in heaven and to bring us to eternal life.' God so loved the world... not God so loved the church. God's love is for everyone! Something that comes across when we welcome families without setting obstacles in the way.

One of the great privileges of meeting families as they seek Baptism for their children is to see the signs of God's presence weaving through their lives. It is a privilege to listen to their stories, because it is so often a chance to hear them talk about God's quiet work in their lives: His gentle call through their experiences of childhood, growing up, and now into parenthood. Having a child raises so many questions about how to be a good parent and how to bring up your children, along with a deeper understanding of the miracle of new birth.

Baptism is a marker on our journey with God, and where that marker sits on the road varies from person to person, but the journey is not restricted to the person being baptised; parents, godparents and the wider family mark their own journeys with God when they commit to exploring faith together. Inviting family and friends to the service means everyone has an opportunity to hear about God's love for them and, equally importantly, to come into God's presence and experience the sacred space created by the Holy Spirit in a unique way.

Please do look in the diary and remember in your prayers the families, friends and godparents of those children coming to Baptism. As we sow seeds of God's love generously into the lives of families, our prayers for them encourage those seeds to grow.
