The MAP... do you know where you're headed? Mission Action Planning: Where is God taking us next?

It's been a busy year with lots of celebrations, including 'the Vicaring' and our recent Confirmations. God is at work in our Benefice and the wind of the Holy Spirit is definitely blowing: bringing people in and bringing change. that is open and inclusive to everyone. I am really pleased to share with you our plans for 'Make Church', a fresh expression of Church that will happen monthly on the third Sunday at 4pm, starting in September. It's exciting to be at the point where we can say 'Now it's time for this!' and I look forward to sharing more details with everyone.

But what else is God calling us to? Where God in each of our three churches? What might God be



nudging us towards? How might we bring His presence to our community in the coming months and years?

On Monday 28th July everyone is invited to join the PCCs at 7pm (venue TBC) for a MAP meeting. It's an opportunity for us to consider our vision and values and to pray for our Benefice and our churches, for our community and everyone in our villages. We will discuss how we might build on the firm foundations God has laid down for us in this place, and consider what next, how and when?

Please come along! This is open for everyone to join in, as we seek the path ahead together.
