If you go into any supermarket from now onwards, you'll know that Christmas is nearly here! The tinsel and the lights, Santa and all his crew; they're out in force. It's all downhill from here to Christmas at high speed! So where does Advent find itself? Squeezed out in the excitement to get to the main event? Well, we are planning to press the pause button and slow things down with our Advent Course!

This year we are exploring Advent through the Archbishop of York's Advent book, *Do Not Be Afraid, the joy of waiting in a time of fear*, written by Rachel Mann. Waiting is a central theme of Advent, as we wait both for the baby Jesus who came at Christmas (the waiting for something that already happened) and as we wait for the coming again of the Risen Jesus in all his glory at the end of time! Watching and waiting is important, but sometimes really hard as well.

Archbishop Stephen introduces the book saying: 'Throughout the book, Rachel uses her wonderful gifts as a poet, priest and theologian to turn our attention to different modes of waiting, but always keeps the focus on Jesus. He is the one we wait for. He is the one who is waiting for us. She reminds us that those famous words of Isaiah, "Do not be afraid..."', are not just a quotable piece of wisdom to adorn a social media post: they are an abiding call from God to trust ever more deeply in him, perhaps most especially when the world seems closest to falling apart. In this book, Rachel returns again and again to the awesome trustworthiness of Jesus who, as God-with-us, knows the cost of being human from the inside, but equally brings us back home to the Father in love and forgiveness.'

Our Course, covering the book over four weeks is designed to follow the four weeks laid out in the book, but because we meet fortnightly we are taking our time and starting in November, online on Tuesday 5th, in person on Thursday 7th. The course is designed so that it doesn't matter if you buy the book and read ahead, if you revisit it afterwards, or if you just come along without the book; we'll cover the key themes and explore them together. So please join us in watching and waiting with JOY!
