Our second session of Make Church focused on the story that Jesus told about the foolish and wise builders. It's a well-known story, which Jesus told as the conclusion to his Sermon on the Mount. Matthew records Jesus's teachings in chapters 5 to 7, and concludes them with him saying: 'Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.'

We had a lot of fun with sand and rocks, and lolly sticks and water, to show that when you build lolly stick houses on the sand and then pour watering cans of rain over them, they fall down. My thanks to all the helpers, especially Peter, who tidied up afterwards! 'The rain came down and the floods came up, and the house on the sand fell flat.'

It has been wonderful to start and develop our new Fresh Expression of Church over the last couple of months. The turnout has been fantastic, with over 20 children and 20 adults at each session, and we are building a team to support the work. Really importantly, this is a new worshipping community; most of these families have not been coming to church, some we have met through Make Lunch, and many are returning baptism families.

It was really good to engage, not just with the children, but with parents and grandparents as well, and to encourage them to reflect on how you build your house on the rock that is God. How do we build our lives with God's love at the centre?

One of the things that has always struck me about this story is that the rain came, the floods rose, the wind blew and beat against both the houses. There is no special treatment for those who believe, the troubles of this world come to everyone, but we stand or fall based on our foundation, on whether we believe and trust in God. And the really great mercy of God is that he picks us up when we fall, forgives us when we sin, and comes looking for us when we get lost.

Our next make Church session is Sunday 16th November at 4pm. Maybe you'd like to come along and see what is happening, what God is up to in this exciting time!
